NEW SANITARY PROTOCOL AS FROM 12th NOVEMBER 2021 USE OF GYMNASIUM / SPORTS COMPLEX

Please note that the following COVID-19 protocols will be in force at all sites managed by this Council.

- 1. A maximum number of 50 persons will be allowed on sports infrastructures, including the staff.
 - Access will be granted to those who are <u>FULLY VACCINATED</u>. It is mandatory for the users to produce their vaccination cards / QR Code together with their National Identity Cards for verification at the entrance. Please note that in case vaccination cards and ID Cards are not produced, access will be denied.

2. Compulsory sanitary measures to be maintained:

- Wearing of masks (to completely cover nose and mouth) before and after practicing activity.
- All users will be subject to temperature check at the entrance of the site. Anyone with a temperature <u>above</u> <u>37.8 degrees will not be granted access</u> to the said sports infrastructure.
- Details of all users (name, contact details, date of utilisation, time of arrival and departure and temperature) will be recorded in the Users Book in order to facilitate contact tracing in case of contamination of COVID-19.

3. Rules and Regulations to be followed:

- Access on site will be granted only to the time of use allocated by this Council (as per details mentioned in the receipt). No extra time will be allocated before and after the activity.
- Only a maximum of 2 users will be allowed per court. (For badminton)
- Only individual training will be authorized. Maintain at least 4 metres distance between participants as established by COVID-19 protocols.
- No competition will be allowed.
- No 'Sports Collectifs' will be allowed.
- Access to conference room will be limited to a certain number of persons maintaining the 4 metres distance.
- Avoid grouping on site.
- No access to cloakrooms / changing rooms.
- No persons will be allowed on the 'gradin'.
- Access on the site will be allowed to users ONLY. (e.g no public / no spectators / no accompanying guests)

PLEASE BE INFORMED THAT ACCESS WILL BE DENIED IN CASE THE ABOVE PROTOCOLS ARE NOT RESPECTED.
